- 4. PC Liaison/committee chair comments:** Bob Mair reported that David Biebel, Chair of Calvary Cemetery Board, shared plans and goals for the cemetery and that they gained needed volunteers from the Mass presentations/testimonials, and several bulletin articles soliciting volunteers.

 - Preliminary numbers were shared regarding the number of sign ups since the May 10/11 Time and Talent drive began. About the same totals as past years, with 2/3 done online, and the majority from SD.
 - Mary Petrie and Lori Woelfel have been asked to update the ministry leads lists for HN & SC; Lori Biebel has assisted with updating it for SD. This will allow for prompt distribution of the sign up data, once it has been sorted by ministry and parish where appropriate.
 - The previously used message to be emailed with sign up data to ministry leads has one change: Omit the last bullet point and replace with “If their time and talent is not needed at this time, please encourage them to become involved in another ministry.”
